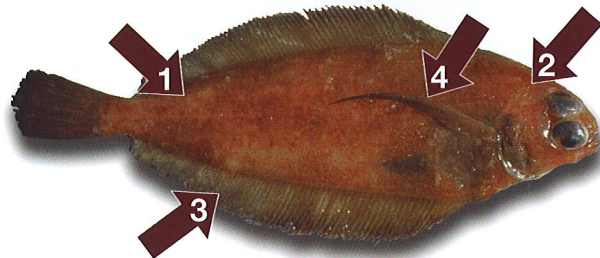


CHARACTERISTICS OF COMMON FLATFISHES

FOUND IN THE NORTHERN GULF OF ALASKA AND BERING SEA

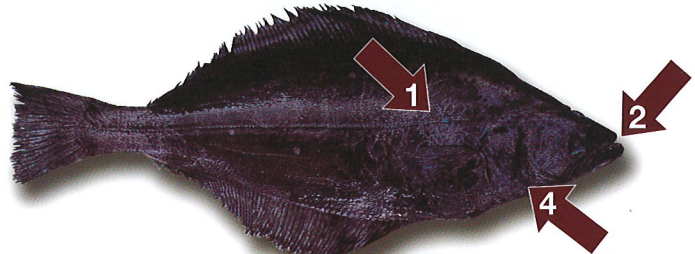


Length to 24 inches (61cm)

REX SOLE

Errex zachirus (formerly *Glyptocephalus zachirus*)
Longfin sole, Witch flounder

- 1 lateral line almost straight
- 2 no accessory dorsal branch
- 3 long, slender flat body
- 4 eyed-side pectoral fin long and mostly black

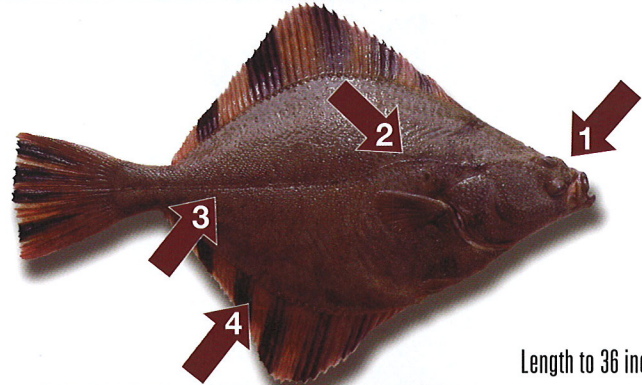


Length to 47 inches (119cm)

GREENLAND TURBOT

Reinhardtius hippoglossoides
Lesser halibut, Newfoundland turbot

- 1 lateral line w/slight slope over pectoral fin
- 2 very large mouth w/strong conical teeth
- 3 dark coloration on blind side
- 4 L-shaped preopercle w/4 or 5 pores near edge around L



Length to 36 inches (91cm)

STARRY FLOUNDER

Platichthys stellatus
Diamond back, Emerywheel, Grindstone

- 1 can be right-eyed or left-eyed
- 2 curve in lateral line over pectoral fin
- 3 rough, star-like scales
- 4 black bars on white to yellow or orange fins
